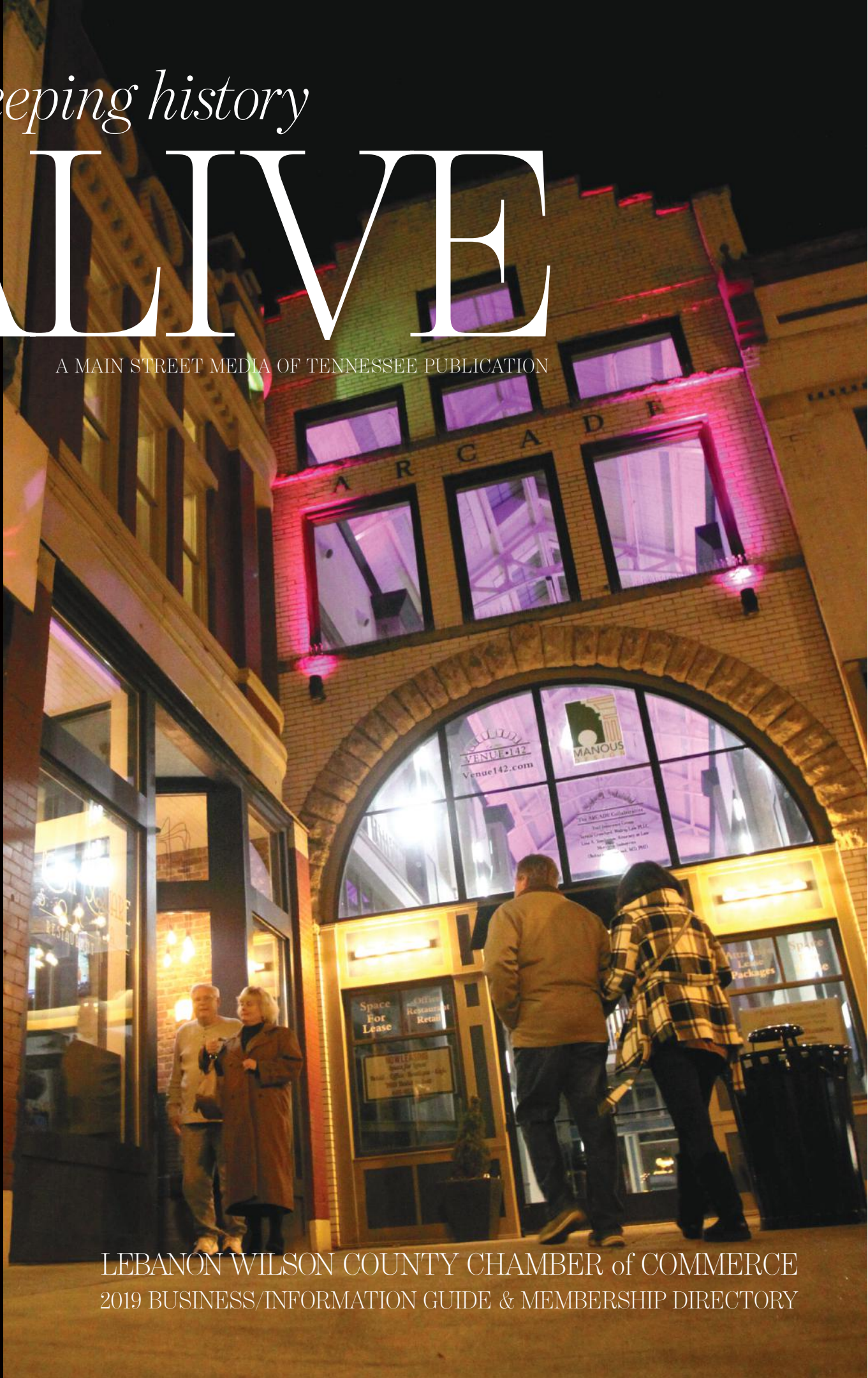

MIKE MANOUS AND HAL BONE

One of only four arcades left in Tennessee, the Lebanon Arcade, known as Venue 142, was purchased by partners Bone and Manous nearly 10 years ago. "When Hal showed it to me, I immediately knew what this building was," said architect Manous. Currently, the 22,000-square-foot building is home to six businesses, including Manous Design, and plans are to explore restaurant opportunities on the first floor. And the second-floor banquet hall served as the home of several Lebanon social clubs across six decades. "We saw its renovation as a service to the community," Bone added.
